

How to Set Up Viper 4 Job Profiles

The following article provides a basic walkthrough on setting up job profiles on a Viper 4. For more information on Viper 4 job profiles, refer to the ROS calibration and operation manuals on RavenHelp.com.

1. Go to the Job Profile Panel.


Select the Job Profile panel.



Select the **Edit** button to create a job profile.


